
Graduates to the Nasdaq-100 Index


Next generation of industries driving tomorrow's innovation

A key measure of a company's commitment to innovation is research and development spending. Nasdaq Next Generation 100 companies continue to reinvest in their own development at a high rate.¹




R&D Expense as % of Revenue



Mid-cap (or mid-capitalization) is the term that is used to designate companies with a market cap (capitalization) between \$2 and \$10 billion USD.

The S&P 400 Index is comprised of 400 companies selected as broadly representative of companies with midrange market capitalization (market valuation of between \$200 million and \$5 billion USD).

The Russell Mid cap Growth Index is a market capitalization-weighted index comprised of 800 publicly traded US companies with market caps of between \$2 billion and \$10 billion USD.

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
